

# FDS setup manual for the PULSE 2

Lay out your kite at a windless place with enough space to unwind your flying lines completely. Make sure that your front lines are not twisted. To untwist them, spin your chickenloop.

## 1. Remove the FLS

You have to remove the Front Line Safety (FLS) to avoid any conflict with two safety systems!

1.1 Remove the FLS-Endline by pulling it through the bar.

1.2 The FDS requires the 2 mm thicker 7/12 mm diameter ring at the end of the depower leader line to avoid the FDS-Weak Point Line getting stuck.

Therefore replace the smaller 5/10 mm ring with the 2mm wider one included in the FDS-Kit.



In order to replace the ring, you have to open the bowline knot at the trimmer. You have to use a bowline knot to reconnect the depower leader line to the trimmer. **Pull the knot really tight!** A short manual at the „support area“ on [flysurfer.com](http://flysurfer.com) explains how to make a bowline knot.

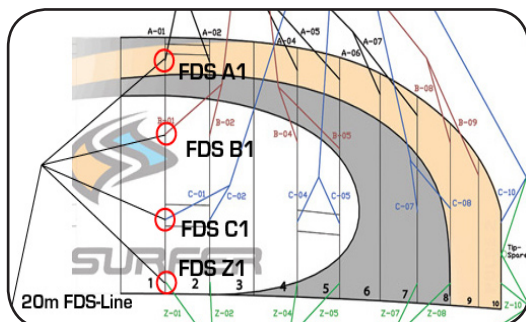
After changing the ring, you have to reconnect the front lines to the end of the depower leader line to the 7/12 mm ring.



## 2. Connect the FDS-Line to the kite

Take the white lines named FDS-A1, FDS-B1, FDS-C1 and FDS-Z1 and connect them directly to the attachment

points marked in the picture to the right. Loop the other side of all 4 lines around one end of the 20m FDS-Line.



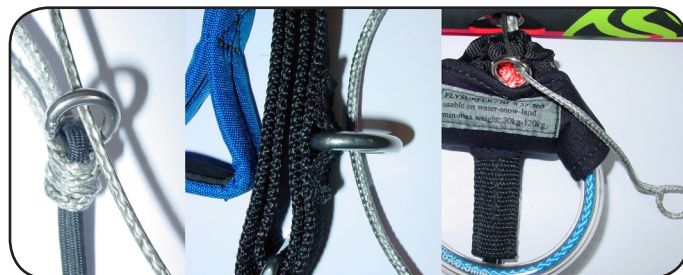
Then loop the small 5/10 mm ring you took out of the depower leader line (1.2) to the white 20m FDS-Line. This stopper will prevent the bar from travelling up more than necessary.



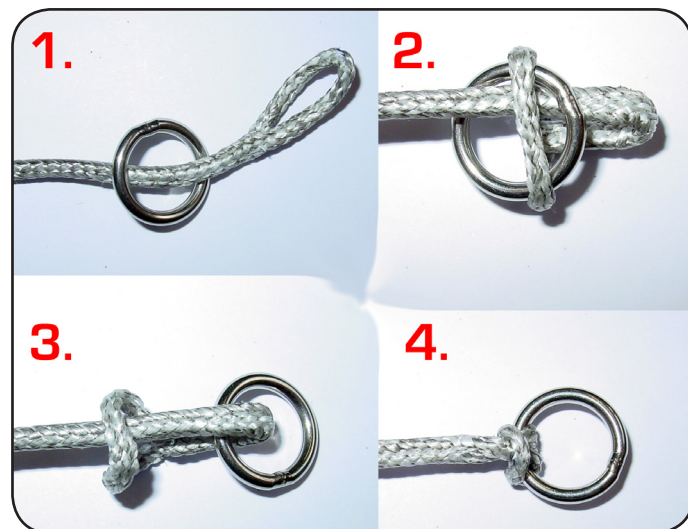
Afterwards loop the 20cm short FDS-Weakpoint-line to the FDS-Endline and then to the 5/10 mm ring.

To complete the FDS, just pull the thick grey FDS-Endline through the:

- 7/12 mm ring you attached to the depower leader line
- steel ring at the trimmer
- hole in the bar and the steel ring at the chicken-loop



Finally connect the biggest 13/18 steel ring to the end of the FDS-Endline.
